ONLINE Innovation & Entrepreneurship Training Course - starting March 16, 2022

Course Objectives

EURECA-PRO/European University on Responsible Consumption and Production is initiating a free **online course on "Innovation & Entrepreneurship"**, consisting of 14 lectures presented by leading professors and researchers of seven European universities from six countries. The main purpose of the "Innovation and Entrepreneurship training course" is to nurture students and scientific staff in creative and innovative thinking by providing practical knowledge, skills and competences in business and market basics, offering business plan orientation, and promoting problem-solution thinking and leadership skills. ECTS
